The Difference Between a Will and a Trust

Wills: Like Having a Picnic on a Blanket

- 1 Public
- Probate process is required
- Multi-state properties = multi state probate courts
- Guardian for minors
- Lifetime protection trust for children (optional)
- Special needs trust or supplemental needs trust (optional)
- Georgia probate fees not expensive
- Hearing Costs (\$\$ and time) Are expensive
- Cannot manage property / sign contracts until someone approved as executor or administrator
- Stress is increased because of the job of understanding and following a legal process, legal documents and maybe a hearing of two

Trusts: Like Having a Picnic with a Basket

- Private
- No probate court intervention
- No multi-state probate court intervention
- Guardian for minors
- Lifetime protection trust for kids (optional)
- Special needs trust or supplemental needs trust (optional)
- Probate fees = \$0
- Hearing Costs = \$0
- Can manage propertry / sign contracts immediately upon the resignation or death of a prior trustee
- Stress is decreased because the trustee is continuing to follow the instructions on the trust
